La Pierre Le Bigaud - Cystic Fibrosis Fundraising

Introduction	This week we are talking to Raymond Tennier and Alain Mével from La Pierre Le Bigaud. In this interview we will be finding out about the sporting events that La Pierre Le Bigaud runs to raise money for research into Cystic Fibrosis.
Marilyn	What are the sporting activities you organise?
English Summary	There are two main events each year. The April Lily of the Valley Ramble at Belle Isle en Terre is open to all, BMX lovers, walkers, canoeists, equestrians and bikers. This year 460 bikers are expected. The Rando Muguet is open to all to enjoy the numerous stalls and activities.
Marilyn	And the other main event?
English Summary	In June there's the cycling rally, La Pierre Le Bigaud. The rally is for both for amateurs and professionals. Last year there were 6,737 participants, all of whom pay an entrance fee.
Marilyn	What's the latest date and time for registration?
English Summary	Well, you need to register by 8.30 on the morning of the rally at Callac.
Marilyn	How do the communes contribute to the rally?
English Summary	Twenty two communes give their support to help finance the rally. The circuit changes every year, so the workload can be shared and it enables us to reach to a wider audience and raise their awareness of cystic fibrosis. We ask each commune to organise some fund raising activities, either before, during or after the rally, all of which boost the sum raised for La Pierre Le Bigaud.
Marilyn	What's the date of this year's La Pierre Le Bigaud rally?
English Summary	This year's event will take place on 27 th June.
